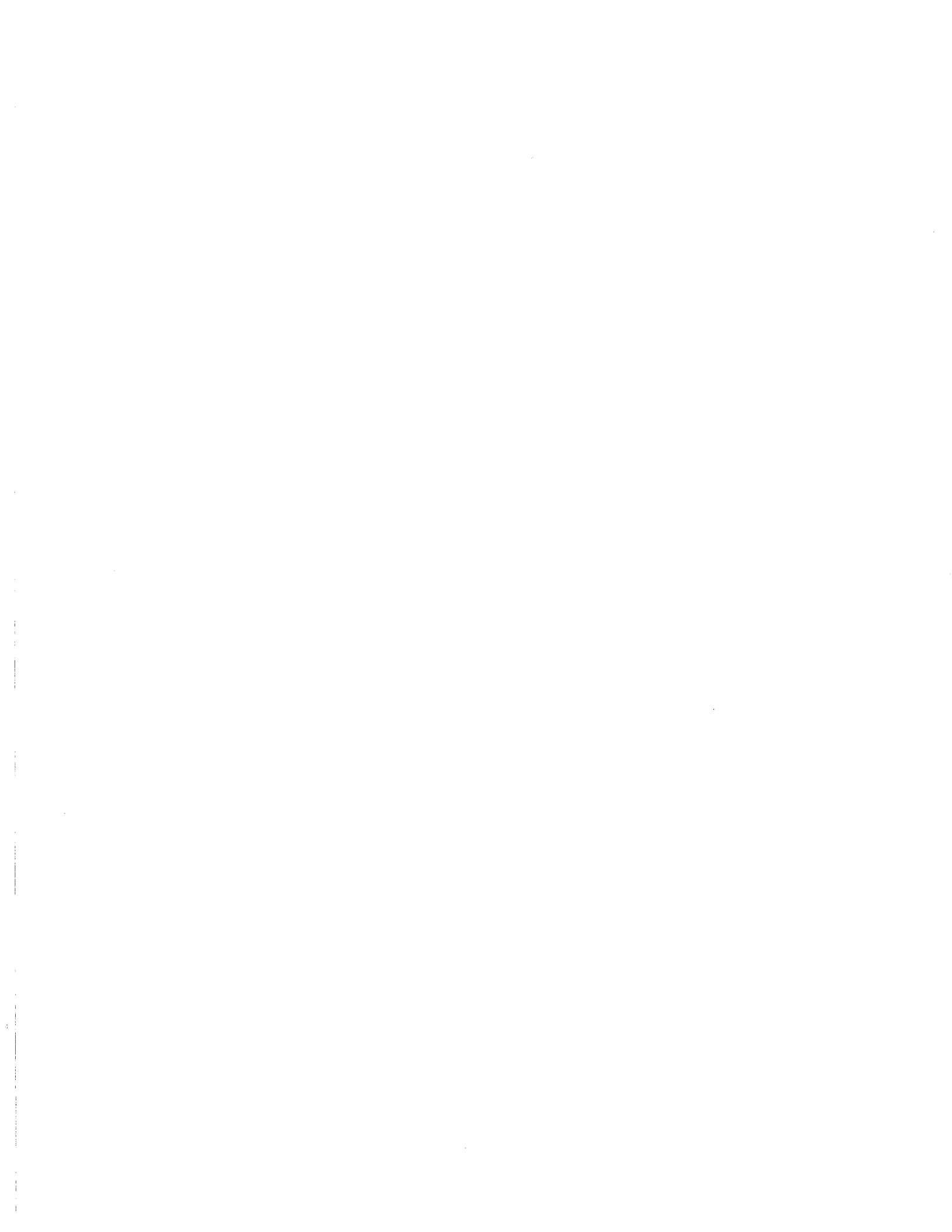




2019-2020 CAVALIERS/HUNTINGTON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Following are the rules for the 2019-2020 **Cavaliers/Huntington Scholarship Program**:

1. To be eligible for one (1) of the ten (10) scholarships awarded by the Cleveland Cavaliers and The Huntington National Bank, an applicant must attend high school in one of the following counties in the state of Ohio: Ashtabula, Cuyahoga, Delaware, Erie, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, Medina, Portage, Summit, Stark or Wayne.
2. Eligible students must complete the official scholarship entry form and enclose a copy of his/her high school transcript reflecting academic achievement through his/her junior year, a letter of recommendation from a faculty member at his/her high school, a 500 word essay on the following question: "What's the most important lesson you've learned up to this point in your life and how do you plan to apply that lesson going forward?" and SAT or ACT scores, if required by the accredited school a student plans to attend.
3. Complete applications must be received by **Friday, February 7, 2020**. The scholarship award announcement and presentation will occur on **Monday, March 30, 2020**. Award of the scholarship may require additional information from the recipient in order to receive the scholarship.
4. Alternates will be selected in the case that initial recipients do not accept or decide not to attend college or pursue a post-high school education.
5. The Cavaliers and Huntington will appoint a committee to screen the applications, interview the twenty (20) semi-finalists on **Thursday, March 6, 2020** and select the ten (10) recipients. The committee will include local educators and employees from each of The Huntington National Bank and Cavaliers Operating Company, LLC. The committee's decisions are at its sole discretion.
6. The committee will screen applications and award scholarships. The criteria are:
 - Academic Achievement (including SAT or ACT scores)
 - Extracurricular Activity (work experience, community involvement, etc.)
 - Essay
 - Interview
7. Employees and the immediate family members of employees of the NBA, Huntington Bank, Cavaliers Holdings, LLC, or their respective affiliates, subsidiaries or parents are not eligible to apply for a **Cavaliers/Huntington Scholarship**.
8. Participation in basketball is not considered a factor in judging extracurricular achievement.
9. This is a one-time, non-renewable scholarship and is to be used towards tuition, books and/or other related educational expenses.
