Form to Decline Whole-Grade Gifted Program Testing

The Ohio Department of Education requires school districts to administer whole-grade testing for the purpose of gifted identification. All 2nd and 5th graders are assessed for superior cognitive and creative thinking giftedness using the InView Cognitive Abilities Assessment and the Scales for Rating Behavioral Characteristics for Superior Students (SRBCSS), and for giftedness in reading or math using the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) test. A parent may decline to have a child participate in any of this testing by submitting this form to the building administrator prior to the scheduled testing.
