FRANKLIN B. WALTER ALL-SCHOLASTIC AWARD

Overview

PROGRAM:

The Franklin B. Walter All-Scholastic Award Program was established by the Ohio Educational Service Center Association to promote student achievement and to recognize outstanding students. A senior from each county within the state of Ohio will receive an award for the 2019-2020 school year.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicant must be a high school senior from a local, city or exempted village school within the ESC's service region. Eligible students must demonstrate outstanding academic achievement as indicated by high school grades, test scores and awards.

The district may ask multiple students to apply but the district must choose only one student application to submit to Tri-County ESC for consideration. Only one high school senior from each county will be chosen to receive the award.

AWARD:

The one student chosen from each county will be invited, along with his/her guests, to attend a special recognition luncheon at the Hilton Columbus at Easton, 3900 Chagrin Drive, Columbus, Ohio. Each winner will receive a \$500 cash scholarship from their representing ESC.

February 21, 2020	Each district must have identified <u>one nominee</u> and forwarded the student's application to Tri-County ESC
March 6, 2020	Applications reviewed by Tri-County ESC Scholarship Committee and one winner from each county chosen for the award
April 27, 2020	Awards presentation at Hilton Columbus at Easton, 3900 Chagrin Drive, Columbus, OH 43219, at 11:30 a.m. luncheon
