### ALL SPORTS BOOSTER CLUB ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP

1. A one-time scholarship in the amount of \$500 to be awarded to 2 individuals who are graduating seniors of Smithville High School.
2. Attend a two-year or four-year college of her/his choice as a full time student.
3. Candidate will be selected on:
  - Having earned two or more varsity letters(including cheerleading)
  - Strong moral character
  - Strong academic achievement
  - Community and school participation
  - Submission of at least one letter of recommendation.
4. Selection committee will be appointed by the Booster Club.
5. Money is to be paid directly to the student.
6. The Booster Club is awarding this scholarship to help young men/women to continue their education toward any appropriate career goal.

### NATHAN DILYARD ART SCHOLARSHIP

1. This one-time \$500 scholarship is given in memory of Nathan Dilyard, who graduated from Smithville High School in 2001 and was attending Malone College majoring in art education.
2. Students applying for this scholarship must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0+ scale and must have taken at least three art classes in high school. (Please indicate number of art classes taken at Smithville High School in question 19 in application)
3. An essay stating your intended major and reasons for your choice is required.
4. Students planning to major in Art or any other education related field.

### OSIE AND LEROY FEUSIER SCHOLARSHIP

1. This shall be a grant of varying dollar amounts each year with a minimum of \$400 awarded to a Smithville High School graduating senior.
2. Preference will be given to a student considering a major in Education and having been accepted by a college or university prior to March 15 of the current school year.
3. Student must pursue a 4-year degree program and will be judged on the basis of:
  - a. Strong academics
  - b. Strong moral character
  - c. Community and school participation.

### GREEN LOCAL EDUCATION ASSOCIATION/OEA/NEA SCHOLARSHIP

1. The Green Local Education Association is offering scholarship grants to approved graduating seniors of Smithville High School who are planning on majoring in education - the number and amount to be determined annually.
2. The graduating senior must be accepted and remain in a Bachelor's Degree program as a declared Education Major at an accredited four year college or university.
3. The graduating senior must be approved and recommended by the Green Local Education Association and its Scholarship Review Committee using objective criteria developed by the Committee.
4. Interested students must submit:
  - a. A Smithville Local Scholarship Application
  - b. A letter of intent to be an education major outlining his/her reasons why he/she should receive the scholarship.
  - c. At least one letter of recommendation.
5. The recipient(s) will receive a check from the Green Local Education Association between August 15 and September 15, upon receipt of evidence that tuition/room/board has been paid.

### ED AND PEG KIFER ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP

1. Awarded to the outstanding senior female and male student athletes.
2. Award is determined by a system of points that the student earns through participation, lettering, and advancing to different levels of state competition in each sport.
3. No application required. The dollar amount varies.

### MARSHALLVILLE LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

1. To be awarded to a graduating Smithville High School senior.
2. Candidate must be accepted as a full time student in either a 2-year associate degree or a 4-year college program.
3. Applicants will be judged on the basis of:
  - a. Scholastic aptitude
  - b. Community and school activity participation
  - c. Financial need.
4. The award is to be paid directly to the school or college and credited to the student's account.

### SMITHVILLE RURITAN SCHOLARSHIP

1. The Smithville Ruritan Club awards several scholarships each year to graduating seniors of Smithville High School. One of these is titled the Feusier-Ruritan Scholarship.
2. Candidates must pursue a 2-year associate program, R.N. nursing, or 4-year college program and be accepted as full-time students.
3. Candidates will be judged on:
  - a. Scholarship
  - b. Financial need
  - c. Moral and ethical character.
4. Money is to be paid directly to the school or college and credited to the pupil's account.

### TUCKER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

1. An annual non-renewable award of \$500 will be made to one or more seniors of the graduating class of Smithville High School.
2. The major criterion for consideration of winners of this scholarship is service within the Marshallville and Smithville communities. Financial need will also be considered.

### SMITHVILLE ALL-SPORTS HALL OF FAME SCHOLARSHIP

1. An annual one year non-renewable award of \$250 will be made out to one boy and one girl of the graduating class of Smithville High School.
2. 2.5 gpa or higher
3. Award based on sports accomplishments and leadership

### WYANT'S HAMMER SCHOLARSHIP

1. A one-time \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior Smithville wrestler or wrestling statistician.
2. Attend a two or four year college.
3. Candidates will be judges on:
  - Strong moral character. Student is a good ambassador for wrestling and school.
  - 3.0 or higher GPA
  - Finish senior season of wrestling season in good standing with wrestling team and with at least  $\frac{3}{4}$  of season finished
  - Finish senior year in good standing with school
  - Essay on how wrestling has impacted their life and how it will assist in making future choices
  - Two letters of recommendation from within school employment (one coach maximum)

### **The Following scholarships below are for Smithville students only but use different scholarship forms.**

#### BLOSSER BROTHERS SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is available to a graduating Senior from Smithville High School who will be enrolled as a full time college student and has financial need. Preference will be toward students who have physical handicaps. If physically handicapped, there is no limitation on the field of study. If not physically handicapped, applicant must be studying some field of agriculture.

1. The fund shall provide a one time \$11,700 scholarship

#### PHYLLIS TROYER SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is available to a graduating Senior from Smithville High School who will be enrolled as a full time college student majoring in Business/Health Care field. Preference will be toward students who have academic accomplishments, Financial need, and Strong Moral Character. Please note that due date is different than local scholarships.

1. The fund shall provide a one time \$1,000 scholarship
2. Applicants will need to pick up a separate Phyllis Troyer application in the guidance office (local scholarship application will not work).

#### DAVID HEDRICK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Applicant must be a current graduating senior or graduate of Smithville High School, located in Wayne County, Ohio. Applicant must be attending or planning to attend an accredited college or university, pursuing a degree in an engineering, math, or science related field. Applicant will be evaluated on high school academic record, high school extracurricular activities, civic and charitable activities, and financial need. This scholarship is not renewable, however previous recipients may re-apply.

1. The fund shall provide a one time \$1,100 scholarship
