Student Achievement Legacy Trust (SALT) Fund

As we approach the season of giving, have you been thinking of ways you can give back this year, but not sure how? By making a donation to the SALT Fund before the end of the year, a donor has graciously agreed to match all donations <u>up to \$10,000.00</u>!

The SALT Fund, created in 2019 (funded only with private donations), is strictly for Green Local Schools, and is invested at the Wayne County Community Foundation (WCCF) on our behalf. Each year the school can take a 4.5% distribution of the fund balance to be used to support "extra" items needed for arts, athletics or academics.

The SALT Fund follows the WCCF mantra of GIVE, GROW, GRANT and is already approaching \$100,000 in total value.

GIVE

- All donors are recognized on our website.
- All donations are tax deductible (to the extent of IRS rules and regulations).
- Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD) are contributions from an IRA that can be made tax free and are a wonderful way to support the school and still satisfy RMD requirements.
- Donate appreciated stock, property, or other investments to the fund to avoid capital gains taxes!
- Make the SALT Fund a beneficiary on a life insurance or IRA account which is also tax free to you and the fund.

GROW


- SALT Fund donations are invested at the Wayne County Community Foundation in an investment portfolio.
- Growth over time is given back to the school to use for various programs.

GRANT

- Each year the school can take a 4.5% distribution of the fund balance to be used to support "extra" items needed for Arts, Athletics or Academics.
- Teachers, coaches, and advisors can apply for funds during the fall grant cycle.
- The SALT Fund committee will evaluate projects and distribute funds to the winning projects.


